RAINFORESTATION:

- 100 acre (40 hectare) tourist attraction, set in the midst of World Heritage Rainforest.
- In operation since 1976 and is locally owned and operated by the Woodward family.
- Situated 30 minutes by coach from Cairns and 5 minutes from Kuranda Village.

Rainforestation has 3 main attractions:

Army Duck Rainforest Tour with Tropical Fruit Orchard (1 hour)



Ride through the magnificent rainforest on an amphibious Army Duck whilst an experienced rainforest guide/driver explains the vast array of local plant life and wildlife.

Also, wander through our Tropical Fruit Orchard which has over 45 different species of tropical fruit trees.

Pamagirri Aboriginal Experience (1 hour)



The Dreamtime Walk - Take an Aboriginal culture tour with the Pamagirri guides, watch spear-throwing and learn to throw a boomerang and play the didgeridoo.

Pamagirri Cultural Centre - A display set in traditional dwellings, where the guides talk about their culture and demonstrate the didgeridoo.

The Pamagirri Corroboree - Dances depicting Aboriginal culture and traditions, performed with the rainforest as backdrop, accompanied by didgeridoo and clapsticks.

Koala & Wildlife Park (30 minutes)

Wildlife Keepers take visitors through the park via elevated boardwalks that allow close-up views of unique Australian animals, including crocodiles, kangaroos, wallabies, dingoes, wombats, the cassowary, lizards and snakes. Have a digital photograph taken holding a cuddly koala, or a small crocodile (optional extras).



All attractions are available as packages or singularly.

Rainforestation features *Colonial & Outback Restaurants* for BBQ lunches and snacks, the *Tropical Treats Juice Bar* for fruits, icecreams, and fresh juices, and *Souvenir Shops* with an extensive range of Australian souvenirs and Aboriginal art and artefacts. A *Shuttle Bus* runs regularly from Kuranda Village.



Groups, Functions, & Conferences

Rainforestation caters to groups of all sizes for any function or event, from informal luncheons or canapés and drinks to exclusive dinners or fully themed extravaganzas. We also offer additional activities for pre-booked groups, such as tree planting, boomerang painting, aboriginal animal tracking, face painting, and sugar cane tasting.
