KOALA AND WILDLIFE PARK

Wander at your leisure through our Koala and Wildlife Park to familiarise yourself with a host of unique Australian wildlife - especially those from North Queensland!

Home to Jack the Ripper, our 5-metre Estuarine Crocodile and Jimmy, the Lumholtz's Tree Kangaroo, you will also meet Cassowaries, Wombats, Tasmanian Devils, Dingoes, and of course our resident Koala population.

With multiple re-entry throughout your day, you may come and go to hand feed the free-roaming Kangaroos and partake in a series of daily Wildlife Keeper Presentations.

PAMAGIRRI ABORIGINAL EXPERIENCE

The interactive Dreamtime Walk includes a guided introduction to age-old hunting techniques using spears and boomerangs where you will have a chance to test your arm at both. Then enjoy the Pamagirri Dancers as they perform traditional dances in the Rainforest Amphitheatre.

The Rainforest Walkabout is a small group experience (maximum 12 guests) where you will spend an interactive 45 minutes with your Pamagirri Guide, who will introduce his culture and history before guiding you into the Rainforest to learn about traditional food and medicinal plants of the area.
